The response to the psalm at our Masses this weekend is:-

This week’s quotation from our **Holy Father Pope Francis**:-

The Sunday Masses of this weekend are the traditional **Gaudete Sunday** celebrations, originally a day to ease the rigours of the Advent fast. The liturgical colour softens from purple to rose pink.

**Congratulations to Frances Guppy and her staff** at our Parish School for the youngsters’ ‘Wiggling Nativity Play’ last Tuesday. Great fun and well done! The whole **school Carol Service** is in our Parish Church on Thursday afternoon at 1:30. All welcome of course.

For **Confessions before Christmas** note the usual times overleaf and in addition an hour on Friday the 21<sup>st</sup> from 11:15 in the Parish Church.

The familiar **Bridport Nativity** is (weather permitting) in Bucky Doo on Saturday morning, the 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 11am. The parish is represented on the cast list!

If you would like to bring to the Parish Mass next Sunday a **figure from your crib at home**, it will be blessed before the altar. This is something that Pope Francis does in Rome, we gather.

Note that there is **no coffee after Sunday morning Mass** next week (23<sup>rd</sup>) but of course there is the special Christmas Tea in the afternoon.

**On each Sunday of Advent a candle is lit** on the Advent wreath at the beginning of Mass as our plans and preparations build for the celebration of the birth of Christ, the Light coming into our world.

As in recent years, **our own Parish Carol Service** is celebrated jointly with our friends at St Swithun’s Church this Sunday (16<sup>th</sup>) at 4pm.

**Lectio Divina- Advent reflections.** For some time now a group of parishioners have been meeting on a Wednesday evening at 7pm to spend a few minutes reflecting on the Gospel reading for the following Sunday and to use the reading as a basis of prayer. Advent is a time to prepare ourselves for Christ’s coming. Why not join us on a Wednesday evening during Advent, You would be most welcome.

We have a **new notice board** in the parish hall, the left hand side of it for anyone who wishes to send a Christmas card to the parish rather than send individual cards. There will be a basket for the money you have saved, which will be donated to **Aid to the Church in Need**, helping suffering and persecuted Christians around the world.

We have just sent a cheque to **CAFOD for £1256** which has been raised from the soup bread and cheese lunches for the last six months, which brings the total raised to £1969. Many thanks to all who have made this possible.

There will be no coffee after the 10am Mass on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> December.**
